1.6 ELECTIONS

1.6.1 <u>VILLAGE CLERK'S ELECTION DUTIES</u>. As provided in § 7.15, Wis. Stats., the Village Clerk shall have charge of and supervise all elections held in the Village.

1.6.2 ELECTION OFFICIALS.

- (a) <u>Appointment</u>. Election officials shall be appointed pursuant to § 7.30, Wis. Stats.
- (b) <u>Number</u>. Except as provided in par. (1.6.2 (c)) below, there shall be 7 inspectors for each election.
- (c) <u>Reduction of Number</u>. Pursuant to § 7.32, Wis. Stats., the Village Clerk may reduce the number of election inspectors for any given election to not less than 3.
- 1.6.3 <u>NOMINATION OF ELECTED VILLAGE OFFICIALS</u>. All candidates for elective Village office shall file nomination papers pursuant to § 8.05 (4)(b), Wis. Stats. and shall be nominated as provided in § 8.05 (4)(a), Wis. Stats.
- 1.6.4 <u>VOTER REGISTRATION</u>. All electors for all elections shall be required to be registered. The Village Clerk shall receive applications for registration at his/her office during regular office hours throughout the year, except that registration may also be completed at Village polling places on election days upon presentation of proper identification and proof of residence.
- 1.6.5 <u>POLLING HOURS</u>. The polls of the Village shall open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. for all elections.
- 1.6.6 <u>WARDS</u>. The entire Village is Ward One.
- 1.6.7 <u>POLLING PLACE</u>. The polling place for the Village shall be the Village Municipal Center.
