7.11 SNOWMOBILES.

7.11.1 STATE LAWS ADOPTED.

(a) <u>STATE SNOWMOBILE LAWS ADOPTED</u>. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this chapter, the statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to snowmobiles in the following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin statutes are hereby adopted by reference and made part of this section as if fully set forth herein. Acts required to be performed or prohibited by such statutes are required or prohibited by this section pursuant to Chapter 350 of the Wisconsin Statutes and/or any successor chapter and are hereby adopted by the Village pursuant to Sec. 350.18(2), Wis Stats.:

(b) State ATV/UTV Laws Adopted. ATV (all-terrain vehicle) and UTV (utility terrain vehicle) shall have the definitions specified in Sec. 23.33, Wis.

Stats. and shall be governed by any state law applicable to such vehicles regarding licensing, rules of the road and/or any other state law specifically applicable to ATV and/or UTV operation.

7.11.2 <u>APPLICABILITY OF RULES OF THE ROAD TO ATVS, UTVS AND</u> <u>SNOWMOBILES</u>. The operator of an ATV, UTV or snowmobile upon a roadway shall, in addition to the provisions of Ch. 350, Wis. Stats. and any other state law applicable to the vehicle in question, be subject to §346.04, 346.06, 346.11, 346.14(1m), 346.18, 346.19, 346.195, 346.20, 346.205, 346.21, 346.22, 346.26, 346.27, 346.33, 346.35, 346.37, 346.39, 346.40, 346.44, 346.452, 346.455, 346.457, 346.46, 346.47, 346.48, 346.485, 346.49, 346.50(1)(b), 346.505 346.51, 346.52, 346.53, 346.54, 346.55, 346.56, 346.63, 346.65, 346.87, 346.88, 346.89, 346.90, 346.91, 346.915, 346.92(1) and 346.94, 346.95, Wis. Stats.

7.11.3 <u>SNOWMOBILE, ATV, UTV AND OTHER OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE</u> <u>OPERATION IN VILLAGE</u>.

(a) Restricted. It shall be unlawful to operate any snowmobile or any other motor-driven craft or vehicle principally manufactured for off-highway use (including golf carts) on private property or on the Village streets, alleys, parks, parking lots, or on any public lands or private lands or parking lots held open to the public, except on the snowmobile or ATV/UTV trail designated by the Village Board.

(b) Exceptions.

- 1. ATV/UTV Route and Trail Operation Exceptions. Snowmobiling and ATV/UTV operation shall be permitted on designated routes and trails approved by the Village Board and designated on the Village Snowmobile Trail Map or Village ATV/UTV Trail Map on file in the office of the Village Clerk. ATV/UTV Route designated streets shall be the following:
 - a. 80th Street North
 - b. County Highway U / North Biron Drive from Huffman Road to 80th Street North
 - c. Anchor Landing Drive
 - d. Bridgewater Drive

- e. Waterview Drive
- f. Bridgeview Drive
- g. Sunset Point Drive
- Snowmobile Operation Exceptions. Pursuant to sec. 350.18 (3)(a) Wis. Stats., and subject to the limitations set forth in § 350.04(2), the Village Board designates that Village roads may be used only for direct access to and from authorized snowmobile trails during times at which such trails are open.
- 3. *Golf Carts*. Golf carts are permitted only on the following Village streets:
 - a. Anchor Landing Drive
 - b. Bridgewater Drive
 - c. Waterview Drive

7.11.4 <u>HOURS OF OPERATION RESTRICTED</u>. No person shall operate a snowmobile, ATV OR UTV anywhere within the Village between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.

7.11.5 SPEED LIMITS.

a) Snowmobile Speed Limit. No person shall operate a snowmobile in the Village at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour.

b) ATV/UTV Speed Limit. No person shall operate an ATV or UTV in the Village at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour on designated ATV/UTV routes or trails regardless of the posted speed limit on any ATV/UTV route listed in this section.

7.11.6 <u>PERMITTING OPERATION BY IMPROPER PERSONS</u> <u>PROHIBITED</u>. No owner or person having charge or control of a snowmobile, ATV or UTV shall authorize or permit any person to operate such snowmobile who is not permitted under State law to operate such vehicle, or who is under the influence of an intoxicant or a dangerous or narcotic drug.

7.11.7 <u>OPERATION WHILE UNDER INFLUENCE PROHIBITED</u>. Section 346.63, Wis. Stats., shall apply to the operation of a snowmobile any place within the Village.

7.11.8 <u>PENALTY</u>. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this section shall be subject to a forfeiture as provided in sec. 25.04 of this Code.

7.11.9 <u>VILLAGE CLERK TO FILE SECTION</u>. Pursuant to §350.047, Wis. Stats., the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to send a copy of this section to the Department of Natural Resources and the Wood County Sheriff's Department.
