FIREWORKS PERMIT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Obtain a Fireworks Permit Application.
- 2. Fireworks Permit application shall be made at least 15 days prior to the event.
- 3. Licensed operators are required to have:
 - a. Pyrotechnic Guild Certification
 - b. Current State of Wisconsin Permit
- 5. Wind Less than 15mph on day of the event
- 6. Insurance is required prior to issuance of permit, for events on Village of Biron property:
 - a. The applicant for a permit must provide an original commercial general liability certificate of insurance, from an insurance company in good standing with the village, with the following coverage limits: a. \$5,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage, with the Village of Biron, its officials, employees, agents and volunteers named as additional insured's; and
 - b. The general aggregate shall be twice the required occurrence limit, or no less than \$10,000,000 per occurrence.
 - c. The original certificate of insurance must be provided to the city directly by the insurance company.
 - d. The certificate of insurance must state that there is a no shooters exclusion and that a cross suits exclusion does not apply to those listed as additional insureds on the certificate
- 7. For private fireworks displays not conducted on public property, before a permit is issued, the applicant shall file with the village a commercial general liability insurance policy in the sum of \$100,000 for the purpose of the payment of all damages to persons or property which arise from or are caused by the conduct of any act authorized by the permit upon which any judicial judgment results. Applications for private fireworks displays and discharge shall be submitted at least thirty (30) days in advance of an event. The Biron Fire Department shall determine the protection level and will provide the protection as needed. **All** fireworks displays **shall** comply with Wisconsin Statue 167.10 and NFPA 1123, safety guidelines of the Pyrotechnic Guild International may also be utilized and referenced.
